DRINK RESPONSIBLY

Get to know the Fredericksburg Region's breweries with these fun facts:

The farm that **1781 Brewing Co.** sits on is the site where Stonewall Jackson's famous arm was amputated in 1863.

The name '**6 Bears & A Goat**' reflects the military backgrounds of the seven owners. Six of the owners are retired from the Coast Guard, which has a bear mascot. The seventh owner graduated from the Naval Academy in Annapolis, whose mascot is a goat.

Prior to the opening of **Adventure Brewing** in 2014, Stafford County was home to only one other brewery, Marlborough Brewery, which operated from 1766 to 1767.

The name **Barley Naked** came to the owner from a dream in 2008, and ten years later that dream became a reality along with a logo that has a hidden image in it.

Highmark Brewery is just one mile from downtown Fredericksburg, features 16 beers on tap, and hosts live music on the weekends!

Maltese Brewing Company was founded and started by firefighters and friends Bobby Cook and Joseph Smith, who share their passion for craft beer outside of their heroic day job.

The name '**Red Dragon**' derives from the owner's Irish, Scottish, and English heritage. The red dragon appears on the national flag of Wales and has symbolized the Celtic nation for more than a millennium.

The **Strangeways** Fredericksburg brewery is located in the former office/warehouse of the Burton family retail clothing business, where owner Neil Burton worked prior to entering the brewing industry.

Water's End Brewery resides in the historic Fredericksburg Square building that was built in 1854. Fredericksburg Square was home to Elks Lodge #875 from 1905–1996. In 1936, for about a year, the Elks leased the space to the United States Postal Service. Today, in the back ballroom, still sits a postal safe.



A TOAST TO REMEMBER

In 2002, Jeff Fitzpatrick blazed the trail for craft beer in the Fredericksburg area. Jeff opened Blue & Gray Brewing Co. in Spotsylvania at a time when there were only about 1,500 microbreweries nationwide. Cheers!
